The regular meeting of the Stevens County Board of Commissioners was called to order at 9:00 a.m., Tuesday, March 9, 2021, by Chair Donny Wohlers. Members in attendance were Wiese, Ennen, Kopitzke, Wohlers and Staples.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Commissioner Ennen moved to approve the Agenda as presented. Commissioner Kopitzke seconded the motion with all members voting aye, motion carried.

Bob Pederson from Donlar Construction gave an overview of Donlar's work over the last year preparing the highway facility for bid. Pederson walked through bid packages including alterations, additions and contingency.


Bob Sworski with CBSquared was present and provided answers to questions the commissioners presented. There was some extended discussion on concrete design and then a stairway for the mezzanine area over wash bay.


Pederson fielded extensive questions from commissioners on bid packages and details related to add/deduct areas.

Board directive to leave parallelogram lift in and take-out hose reels, electing to self-perform this work. After feedback from Sworski and Pederson, there was board consensus to go with a less costly fiberglass window option.

Commissioner Kopitzke motioned to direct Bob Pederson with Donlar to draft GMP contract with the addition of package related to parallelogram lift, remove the hose reel add, and go with less costly fiberglass windows. Commissioner Staples seconded the motion with all members voting aye, motion carried. Donlar will prepare the GMP contract for full board approval on the 3/16/2021 meeting.

Having no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:03 a.m. on a motion by Staples, second by Kopitzke and all members voting aye.
